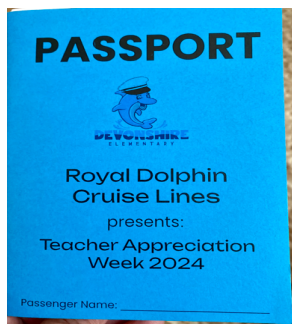
Hidden Valley Elementary

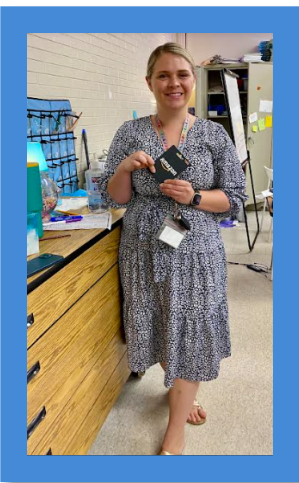
